
RESIDENTIAL ROOF TO TIMBER FRAMING

- Wind zone is very high or extra high (E2/AS1, Figure 45)














RESIDENTIAL ROOF TO TIMBER FRAMING









RESIDENTIAL HORIZONTAL CLADDING





RESIDENTIAL VERTICAL CLADDING




